• Developing relations with Chinese authorities and carrying out negotiations for approved training certification on the Chinese side

- Identifying the rules and requirements from Chinese side to provide aviation training in Europe February May 2020;
- Activating/conducting the certification process if needed –
 May December 2020; (THIS NEEDS a LOT OF WORK)
- Signing corresponding agreements between European partners and with Chinese September-December 2020.
